

In light of the recent severe weather in Illinois, Governor Bruce Rauner declared Alexander, Calhoun, Cass, Christian, Clinton, Cumberland, Douglas, Iroquois, Jackson, Jersey, Lawrence, Madison, Marion, Menard, Monroe, Morgan, Moultrie, Pike, Randolph, Richland, Sangamon, St. Clair and Vermilion counties state disaster areas. As a result, the Illinois Department of Insurance (DOI) issued [Company Bulletin 2015-13](#) to provide certain safeguards to consumers affected by the severe weather.
